

DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY WITH ROHS DIRECTIVES 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU

The Delegated Directive 2015/863/EU (RoHS III), which updates Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS II), provides that electrical and electronic equipment does not contain the substances listed below and reported in Annex II "Substances with restrictions on use referred to in art. 4(1) and values of the maximum permissible concentrations by weight in homogeneous materials":

- Lead (0.1 %)
- Mercury (0.1 %)
- Cadmium (0.01 %)
- Hexavalent chromium (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1 %)
- Di-phthalate (2-ethylhelesyl) (DEHP) (0.1 %)
- Benzylbutyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1 %)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1 %)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)

H.T.P. High Tech Products S.R.L. declares that articles placed on the market that do not include brass components (copper alloy), have a content of substances "with restriction of use" lower than the values prescribed in Annex II to the Directive.

Articles placed on the market that include brass components (copper alloy) are exempted as they are included in Annex III (unrestricted applications) to the Directive:

Substance with restriction of use (Annex II to the RoHS Directive)	Exemption from restrictions (Annex III to the RoHS Directive)
Lead (Pb)	Copper alloy containing up to 4% lead (Pb) by weight (exemption 6 c)
